







Alexander Stevenson – Still Waters Run Deep

Alexander is interested in tracing an alternative take on Cheltenham's origin myth. Seemingly unlikely connections will form between town-founding pigeons, navigation, coded messages, GCHQ, and the ever present spa waters.



In an experimental 4 week period, the artist will walk the streets of the spa town feeding back what he finds to the 'embassy' that will be created at the Hardwick Gallery. Results will form video, costumes and installation in the gallery as well as interactions across Cheltenham with local interest groups such as pigeon fanciers and archivists.


The Isbourne are looking for a piece of original artwork to feature in their Autumn/Winter 2019 programme cover.
